1. PURPOSE:

The purpose of these service request is to invite bids from the potential bidders for the provision of calibration; repairs and maintenance of PAPI's for the period of thirty-six (36) months at Polokwane International Airport.

2. BACKGROUND:

GAAL requires to appoint the service provider for the provision of calibration; repairs and maintenance of Precision Approach Part Indicators (PAPI's) for the period of thirty-six (36) months at Polokwane International Airport.

It is a requirement that the institution develop a maintenance programme for the equipment, maintain and calibrate such equipment on quarterly basis to ensure compliance with applicable requirements.

Maintenance of equipment should be done as and when the equipment's are unserviceable which must be followed by verification of the affected PAPI.

3. REQUIRED SERVICES

The services required are as follows but not limited to:.

- The provision of PAPI's lights repairs and maintenance
- Calibration of PAPI's quarterly (April, July, September, December)

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7. TERMS AND CONDITIONS

7.1 Supplier Due Diligence

7.1.1 GAAL reserves the right to conduct supplier due diligence prior to final award or at any time during the contract period and this may include pre-announced/ non-announced site visits. During the due diligence process the information submitted by the bidder will be verified and any misrepresentation thereof may disqualify the bid in whole or parts thereof.

7.2 Counter Conditions

7.2.1 Bidders' attention is drawn to the fact that amendments to any of the bid conditions or setting of counter conditions by bidders may result in the invalidation of such bids.

7.3 Negotiation

7.3.1 GAAL reserves the right to negotiate with the preferred bidders prior to award and with the successful bidders(s) post award.
