3.1.3 1 x Explosive Trace Detection Device

3.1.3.1 Introduction

The explosive trace detector should be capable to detect traces of explosives and narcotics. Explosive Detectors is a non-destructive inspection process to determine whether a container contains explosive material.

3.1.3.2 Detection Capacity

The equipment should be able to detect explosives such as RDX, PETN, NG, TNT, HMX, TATP and other explosives.

3.1.3.3 Specifications

Sensitivity

- It should be in 1×10^{-12} gm/cm³ or better for vapor.
- The detector should be able to detect all types of organic and inorganic explosives in vapors, liquid, powder, particle and mixture form at varying temperature without touching the suspected item.
- Minimum 10 samples of explosives should be kept inside a container and detector separately.
- The container should be closed.
- Each sample inside the container to be checked with the explosive detector separately.
- Samples to include swiped, contained, powdered, spilled and liquid.
- Samples to be checked / detected at varying temperatures.
- The detector should be able to detect all types of explosives.

Selectivity

- System should not respond to odor of non-explosive substances.

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- Non explosives should be kept with / without the explosive samples in separate containers.
 - All these samples should be checked with the explosive detector.
- Specificity
- False alarm rate should be less than 5%.
 - Explosive and nonexplosive samples to be placed inside different containers separately and should be checked with the detector.
- Auto Calibration Adjustment / Resetting for further operations should be automatic.
- Warm up Time System to stabilize quickly and ready for typical operation in 24X7.
- Analysis Time Should be less than 30 seconds. The same should be timed using stopwatch.
- Electromagnetic Interference Operations should not be affected by electromagnetic interference of other electronic / magnetic devices.
- Operating Temperature a. -10'C to +50'C
b. Humidity up to 95% non-condensing.
- Enclosure Class IP Equipment must have weatherproof casing with IP 67 compliance for outdoor applications.
- Indication Equipment should give out both visual and audio alarm signal.
- Versatility Equipment should be rugged for security use and should be able to function correctly in all weather conditions prevalent in South Africa
- Ease of Operation Results given by the detector / equipment should be self-explanatory and should not require any reference.

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The maximum points that can be scored on functionality equals to 75. Suppliers scoring less than 50 points will be disqualified.

Suppliers that fail to meet the minimum threshold for functionality will be disqualified. Thereafter, **only the qualifying bids will be evaluated in terms of the 80/20.**

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- 1.5 Failure on the part of a bidder to submit proof of B-BBEE Status level of contributor together with the bid, will be interpreted to mean that preference points for B-BBEE status level of contribution are not claimed.
- 1.6 The purchaser reserves the right to require of a bidder, either before a bid is adjudicated or at any time subsequently, to substantiate any claim in regard to preferences, in any manner required by the purchaser.

2. DEFINITIONS

- (a) **“B-BBEE”** means broad-based black economic empowerment as defined in section 1 of the Broad-Based Black Economic Empowerment Act;
- (b) **“B-BBEE status level of contributor”** means the B-BBEE status of an entity in terms of a code of good practice on black economic empowerment, issued in terms of section 9(1) of the Broad-Based Black Economic Empowerment Act;
- (c) **“bid”** means a written offer in a prescribed or stipulated form in response to an invitation by an organ of state for the provision of goods or services, through price quotations, advertised competitive bidding processes or proposals;
- (d) **“Broad-Based Black Economic Empowerment Act”** means the Broad-Based Black Economic Empowerment Act, 2003 (Act No. 53 of 2003);
- (e) **“EME”** means an Exempted Micro Enterprise in terms of a code of good practice on black economic empowerment issued in terms of section 9 (1) of the Broad-Based Black Economic Empowerment Act;
- (f) **“functionality”** means the ability of a tenderer to provide goods or services in accordance with specifications as set out in the tender documents.
- (g) **“prices”** includes all applicable taxes less all unconditional discounts;
- (h) **“proof of B-BBEE status level of contributor”** means:
 - 1) B-BBEE Status level certificate issued by an authorized body or person;
 - 2) A sworn affidavit as prescribed by the B-BBEE Codes of Good Practice;
 - 3) Any other requirement prescribed in terms of the B-BBEE Act;
- (i) **“QSE”** means a qualifying small business enterprise in terms of a code of good practice on black economic empowerment issued in terms of section 9 (1) of the Broad-Based Black Economic Empowerment Act;
- (j) **“rand value”** means the total estimated value of a contract in Rand, calculated at the time of bid invitation, and includes all applicable taxes;

3. POINTS AWARDED FOR PRICE

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3.1 THE 80/20 OR 90/10 PREFERENCE POINT SYSTEMS

A maximum of 80 or 90 points is allocated for price on the following basis:

80/20 or **90/10**

P_s = Points scored for price of bid under consideration
